**13:45-14:00** Introduction to the project, its objectives and contents: Transboundary World Heritage as potential for Europe and its future. Speaker: Prof. Dr. Marie-Theres Albert, Director of the IHS

**14:00-14:45** Transboundary World Heritage sites in Europe and their potential for sustainable cultural, social and economic development in transnational cooperation:

**14:00** Muskauer Park - Park Mużakowski (German-Polish UNESCO World Heritage Site) and Muskauer Faltenbogen - Łuk Mużakowa (German-Polish UNESCO Global Geopark). ### **14: 45-16:30 Working groups on the sites:**

An international working group for each site: Muskauer Park - Mużakowski Park and Muskauer Faltenbogen - Łuk Mużakowa, Montanregion Erzgebirge / Krušnohoří, Limits of the Roman Empire. Exchange and discussion in three groups, each with a summary. Each group will be supported by interpreters:

**14:45** Inventory: Positioning of the states and project schools on the topic of World Heritage and Europe, using the example of the three World Heritage sites. Does a political and practical interest exist in a thematic framework about World Heritage in Europe to be implemented in schools and if so, how is this framework supported politically and/or financially? How good is the cooperation between different institutions involved in this network; such as the political sector, the educational sector or the sector of conservation and restoration of heritage? What are the potentials for schools



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and pupils implementing the intercultural and interdisciplinary cooperation and how can the cultural and political message be transmitted to pupils and via them.

**15:20** Mediation: Exploring the situation of the three transboundary World Heritage Sites, which allows pupils and students to participate actively in the European transboundary idea. Discussion of recollection and learning from history, of experiences at borders and at meeting spaces, and of common concepts of sustainability to support intercultural educational dialogue.

**15:55** Implementation: Exchange on the optimal input of analogue and media instruments as concrete support and promotion of students' intercultural treatment with the topic of World Heritage, taking into consideration the different sustainable ways to present, participate in and shape the idea of Europe, by exemplifying the three European transboundary sites.

**16: 30-17:00** Summary and Outlook
