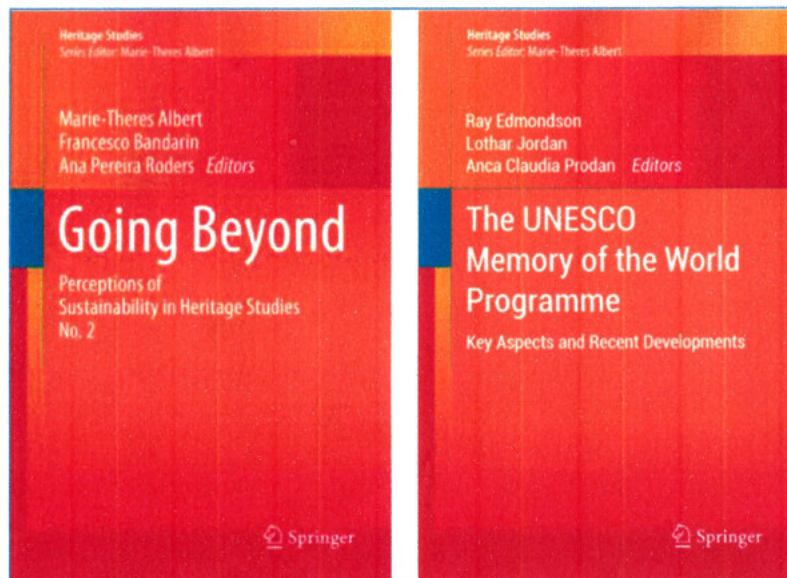

- Anchoring Heritage Studies in the scientific discourse.

Future Activities to address the SDGs
