Introduction

1. 3 workshops will be held with students and teachers from the UNESCO Project Schools located in the transboundary sites. They shall prepare the contents and topics for a digital platform with focus on “UNESCO World Heritage and Europe today”:
Goals, contents and implementation strategies shall be discussed and prepared
2. A digital platform with educational videos prepared by students and teachers shall be presented:
Strengths, weaknesses and implementation strategies will be discussed and decided
3. The project provides training for teachers to conduct the workshops with the expected outcome:
Participants and dates for this training have to be confirmed
4. The number of school teachers and students have to be confirmed: the indicators say 3 schools in Saxony plus another federal State in Germany, Poland, Czech Republic and/or UK, Denmark

Goals and contents of the digital platform

The platform's purpose is to digitally communicate shared European World Heritage and to provide the users with background information about the contents and goals of the project. The platform aims to create awareness via contents and media design. It serves to safeguard the outcomes and to publicise the project results. It demonstrates furthermore how UNESCO Project Schools can use their network by working together on UNESCO topics.

Contents

- World Heritage for Europe – what does it mean?
- Concept and significance of transboundary UNESCO World Heritage sites in Europe – what are the chances for a sustainable future and peace in Europe?
- Presentation of the sites involved and their shared history, graphically depicted through photos and maps;
- Shared perspectives and the advantages as well as the disadvantages of inter-state collaboration;
- etc..

Exchange, discussions and their results in three sections, dedicated to the topics:

1.Inventory 14:45

Political, institutional and practical interest about World Heritage in Europe implemented in schools. Intercultural and interdisciplinary cooperation between different institutions involved in this political, educational and protective network etc.

Expected results:

Chances and challenges of transboundary cooperation for institutions and students involved.
Perceptions of sustainability in shaping Europe.

2.Mediation 15:20

Exploring the situation of the sites involved, which allows students and teachers to participate actively in the European transboundary idea. Discussion of: learning from history, experiences at borders, meeting spaces of the sites, common concepts of sustainability, intercultural educational dialogue etc.

Expected results:

Topics and themes, exciting for pupils, feasible for teachers.

3.Implementation 15:55

Exchange on the optimal input of analogue and media instruments as concrete support and promotion of students' intercultural treatment with the topic of the World Heritage sites and Europe.

Expected results:

Clearly defined support and needs in implementing the project. A future workshop with cooperating schools and partners of the sites together with a media educator is in progress and planned for March 2019.
